



RULES FOR THE USE OF THE SEASCOUTCENTRE “KAGERPLASSEN”

2017

These rules are the limited and translated version of Dutch rules 2017.

GENERAL ITEMS

Arrival and departure.

Upon arrival and departure it is obligatory to report at the supervisor, Mr. J Hoogenboom (or his representative) who lives opposite the Sea scout Centre next to the mill. Address Zijldijk 4 2362 AE Warmond. Any order given by the supervisor and/or members of the board of the Sea scout Centre have to be followed.

Deposit

With the camp fee, an amount for deposit was charged. If your camp terrain is left clean/proper, and your group has behaved properly during the camp, the deposit will be restituted on your bank account, next September.

Limitation of liability

The board, or members of the board of the foundation Sea scout Centre Kagerplassen are not liable for physical injuries and/or property damage, in what form whatsoever, associated to the use of the island, the windmill or the mill yard.

Parking

Parking of cars and/or trailers is only allowed on the official parking places alongside the road opposite the sea scout centre. The local Police is very strict on this rule.

Since the Centre is located on an island it is not possible to have cars or trailers on the terrain.

Dogs

Dog and other pets will not be admitted to the center.

Belongings of normal (regular) users

During the whole sailing season, the Sea scout centre is in use by 20 sea scout groups from the surroundings. They have boats and other equipment stored on the centre. It is not allowed to use their belongings.

TERRAIN/CAMPING

Responsibility

The person mentioned in the camping permit is responsible for all activities of persons of the whole group. Each user refrains from causing trouble to other persons. Any kind of damage to materials, houses, toilets, vegetation, ditches and draining systems should be avoided.

Use of alcohol

Since the sea scout centre is a terrain for youth activities there are some restrictions on the use of alcohol. Alcoholic beverages are only to be drunk in the direct vicinity of the own tents. Use is only admitted to persons above 17 years of age (Dutch law). Stocks have to be kept out of sight. Draught beer installations over 10 liters are not admitted. Misbehavior on this rule can lead to a compulsory removal of the whole group.

Toilets

Toilets are to be kept clean by the users of the Sea scout Centre. Flushing of the toilets is done by hand pumps. Flushing has to be done with lots of water and other items should not be thrown in the toilets but are to be disposed of through garbage bags.

Electricity



A limited capacity of 230 V electricity is available. Maximal capacity is 4 Ampere, which is approximately 900 Watts. In the toilet building are CEE wall plugs installed. Besides the outlets in the toilet building four more outlets can be found at several places all over the island as indicated on the map. From there your own cables have to be used to bring the electricity to the tents. Only the use of CEE norm plugs is allowed (CEE-Form 16A-6h/ 200-250 V 2p + N).

Drinking water

Taps for drinking water are situated next to the toilet building. The use of these taps for washing or dishwashing is not allowed. For washing a sink is situated inside the toilet building.

Digging

It is not allowed to dig anywhere on the Sea scout Centre.

Ditches and bushes

It is not allowed to walk through the bushes, to use the ditches or to chop or cut in the trees or shrubs.

Picket poles.

The use of picket poles or alike is not allowed without the permission of the supervisor in order to protect the drainage system.

Flagpole

The flagpole can be used to hoist your own flag. The middle line, on the gaff is exclusively for the Dutch national flag. The most northern line is exclusively for the Sea scout Centre flag. The others lines can be used.

fire extinguishers.

At each cooking facility a fire extinguisher should be at hand.

Bicycles

Bicycles are not allowed on the campsite; they should be placed near the mill at the designated place.

ENVIRONMENT

Litter

Litter cannot be disposed on the island. It has to be disposed in the waste disposal containers situated opposite the island, next to the road.

Campfires

Campfires are only possible using special fireplaces, any other way is not allowed. Wood for campfires are only limited available. The use of wood fires other than for campfires is not allowed.

Contaminated fluids.

Contaminated fluids should not be left behind but deposited at the delivery points in Leiden or Kaagdorpe.



Campers should have boats for own use available. The sea scout Centre has no boats available to lend out to campers.

Ships can be moored in free mooring places. If the regular user of the mooring place returns boats should be relocated. Boats should be moored in a proper way with sufficient mooring lines as shown in the above drawing..

Temporary mooring at the roadside of the water can be done opposite the windmill, west of the waterway to the windmill. Because space is limited mooring is for loading/offloading only. The small yellow boat is for use by the regular users of the center.
